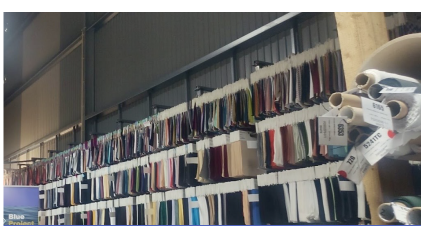

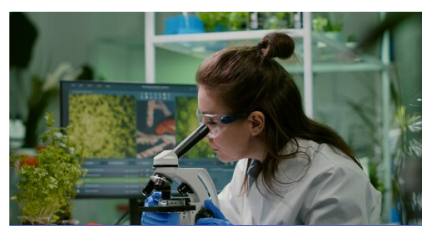
#### The competitiveness of companies through innovation and modernization
